Frequently Asked Questions:

What is a Revival?

An Episcopal revival is a dedicated series of gatherings that combine inspiring worship, compelling teaching, honest faith-sharing, intensified prayer, and some form of engagement with the mission of God — all for the sake of the spiritual renewal and transformation of people and of society.

When is the Revival?

Friday, April 26 and Saturday, April 27, 2024

Where does it take place?

Trinity Cathedral in midtown Sacramento, and St. John's church in Roseville.

What happens at the Revival?

A spirit-filled service filled with prayer, music, and preaching. Our featured speaker will be the Most Rev. Michael Curry, Presiding Bishop of the Episcopal Church.

Will Revival Workshops be livestreamed?

No. They will be recorded for later viewing on our website

How much does it cost to attend the Revival?

Nothing. All public events and transportation are free. Food and beverages will be available for purchase at the Revival Festival.

How do I get there?

We will charter buses to bring folks throughout the diocese to the Revival. You may drive yourself, of course. We encourage car-pooling.

I'm traveling a long distance, will there be a hotel nearby?

We are currently negotiating special rates for overnight accommodations. Please indicate on the survey if you are interested.

Where will the Revival Service take place?

At St. John's Church in Roseville. We will be erecting a large tent with theatre style seating, staging, lighting, and sound system. You will not want to miss this!

What if I don't want to be in the tent?

We will have overflow seating in the sanctuary

Will the Revival Service be livestreamed?

Partially. We will have one simulcast location at Christ Church, Eureka for the Revival Service. This will be a live video link allowing viewers to participate. There will also be a chartered bus from Eureka for those who wish to attend in person.

Is this only for Episcopalians?

No. We want all people to feel welcome to share the love of Christ at the Revival.

Will I need a ticket to attend the fundraising dinner?

Yes. This will be a paid event. Stay tuned for details.

Will I need a ticket to attend other Revival events?

No. However, we will have a website for participants to register, so we can have an accurate idea of anticipated attendance for each event.

How is the Revival being funded?

The Board of Trustees has authorized significant funding to underwrite the Revival. We are asking churches to hold fundraising events to help defray the costs.

On Friday evening, there will be a special invitation-only dinner with Bishop Curry for individual donors who have helped underwrite the events. If you are interested in supporting the Revival with a significant gift, please contact the [Rev. Cn Julie Wakelee](#).
